1 Installation

Two ways to do it:

1.1 By connecting to Prestashop Addons

- Go to the "Module Manager" page from the menu of your back office,
- Click on the "Connect to Addons Marketplace" button at the top right of the page,
- Enter your Prestashop Addons credentials,
- All your purchases will appear on this page, you just need to install the desired module by clicking on "Install" in front of the module to install it.

1.2 By downloading the .zip file

- Go to the "Downloads" page of your Prestashop Addons account (<https://addons.prestashop.com/en/agency-products.php>),
- Download the module with the compatible version to your Prestashop,
- Go to the "Module Manager" page from the menu of your back-office,
- Click on the "Install a module" button at the top right of the page,
- Drag and drop the downloaded module.

2 Configure the module

2.1 Introduction

The configuration of the module will allow you to change the display of the reference of your customers. Here is the screen of this page:

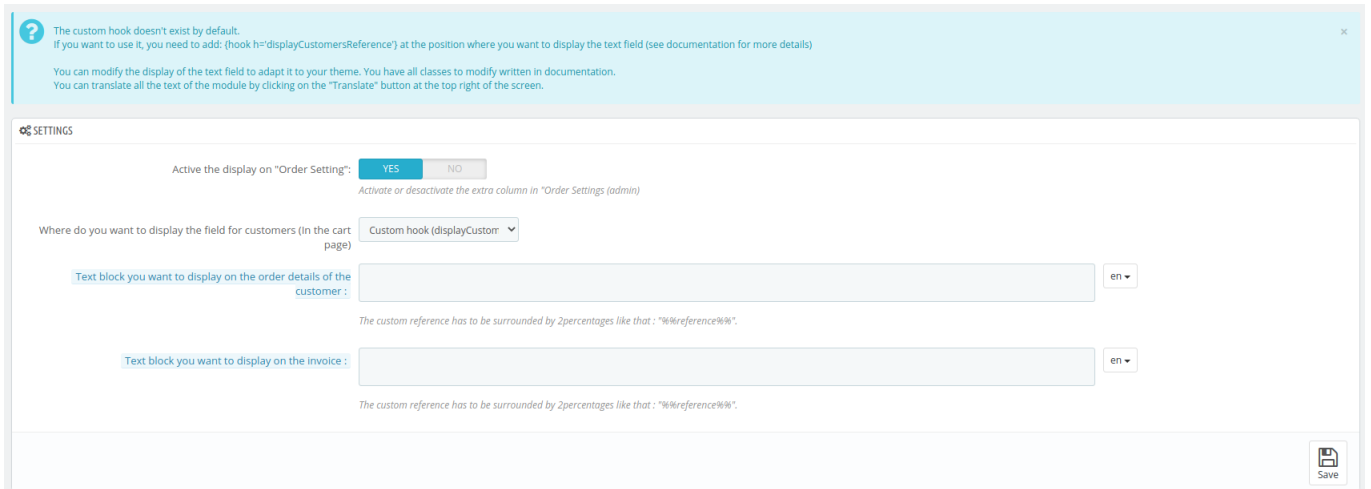


Figure 1: Configuration of the module

2.2 Fields presentation

Switch button

The first field is a button allowing you to activate or not the display of customer references on the "Order settings" list.

Dropdown list

The second field is a drop-down list allowing you to define the location on which the field must be on the cart of your customers.

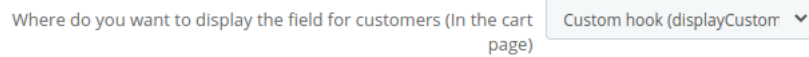


Figure 4: Dropdown list on the configuration

You have 3 options :

- Below the product list
- Above the order summary
- Custom hook

Here is an overview for the first two options (displays may be different depending on your theme):

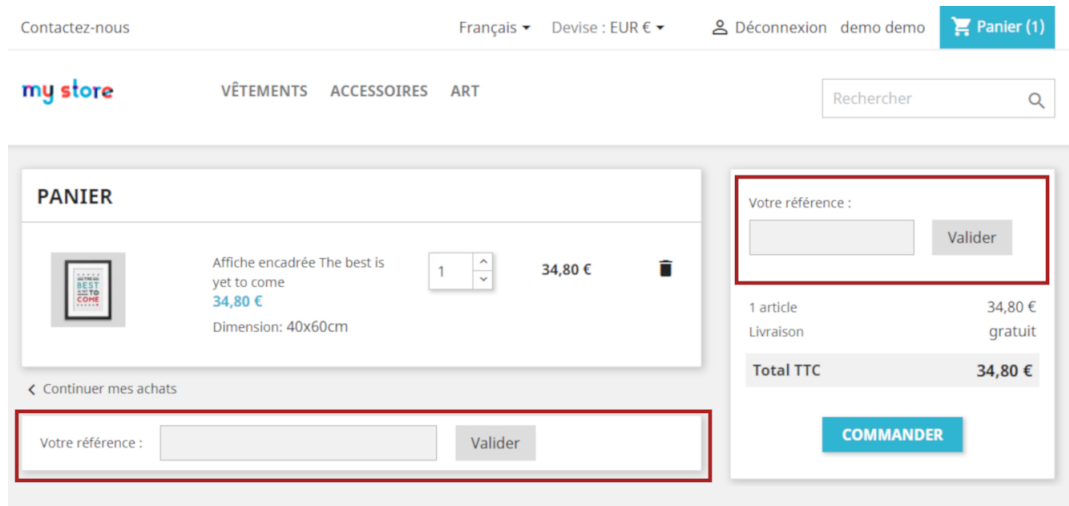


Figure 5: Location of the field

Regarding the last option, please go to the "Customize field location" part of the documentation.

Text fields

The last two fields are text fields allowing you to change the text displayed on the customer's order detail as well as on his invoice. The customer's reference will be designated by the character string "

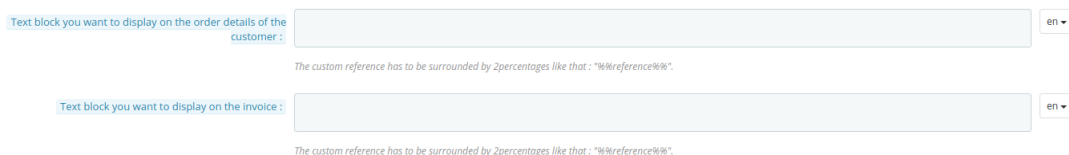


Figure 6: Text fields on the configuration

3 Customize field location

If you have selected the custom hook location in the configuration, then you can display the field wherever you want on your store. Here's how to add it to the checkout steps:

- connect to the files of your server using FTP,
- go to the root of your store and this path : "themes \{name_of_your_theme} \templates \checkout _partials",
- edit the file "cart-summary.tpl",
- this file is used to display the order summary block :

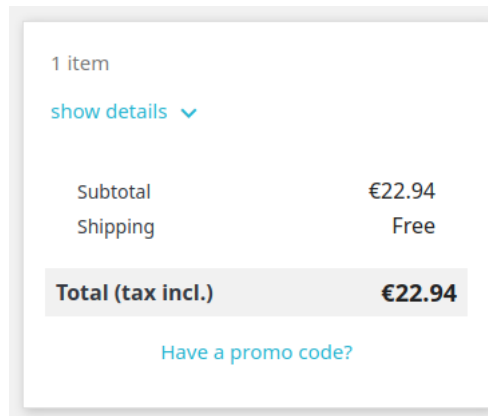



Figure 7: Order summary

- to display the reference field at the bottom of this block, go to the bottom of the file and copy this line before the tag "</section>": "{hook h='displayCustomersReference'}". The final code :

4 Change the appearance of the field

The module uses Prestashop attributes for display. If the display of the field does not suit you and does not respect your theme, you can change the appearance using the CSS classes used. Of course, you will need to be comfortable with CSS to be able to modify the appearance. This file can be found from: "modules\customersref\views\templates\front\displayCustomersReference.tpl".
