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1 Installation

Two ways to do it:

1.1 By connecting to Prestashop Addons

- Go to the "Module Manager" page from the menu of your back office,
- Click on the "Connect to Addons Marketplace" button at the top right of the page,
- Enter your Prestashop Addons credentials,
- All your purchases will appear on this page, you just need to install the desired module by clicking on "Install" in front of the module to install it.

1.2 By downloading the .zip file

- Go to the "Downloads" page of your Prestashop Addons account (<https://addons.prestashop.com/en/agency-products.php>),
- Download the module with the compatible version to your Prestashop,
- Go to the "Module Manager" page from the menu of your back-office,
- Click on the "Install a module" button at the top right of the page,
- Drag and drop the downloaded module.

2 Settings

2.1 Presentation of the different screens

2.1.1 Table listing all editable lists

This table shows all editable lists. To modify a list, simply click on the "Edit" button in front of the list to modify. The redirected page will allow the customization of the columns of this list:

2.1.2 Customizing the columns of a list

You will arrive on a page equivalent to this one:

As you can see, this page is divided into three sections:

Quick add : this part allows you to add columns commonly used by users. If a column suits you in the drop-down list, select it and click on the "Add" button at the bottom right of the section. If you wish to have access to another field which is not in the list, click on the "Add a column" button at the top right of the screen (see the "Add form" part for the configuration).

Table : this table lists all the columns to display in the selected back office list. You can modify the title as well as the type of the field (the saving is done automatically). To change the position of the columns, click to the left of a row and drag it to the position you want. You can save a configuration using the templates (see the "Templates" section).

Global config : this part allows you to replace or not the default Prestashop columns with personalized ones. This configuration will be taken into account when saving a template.

2.1.3 Add form

If the columns entered in the quick add form do not suit you, this form displays all the database fields compatible with the back office list to modify.

Small vocabulary point: a database table is made up of several fields and data. We can make the comparison with a Prestashop list where the fields would be the headers and the data corresponding to the rows.

In the first section, you can see a drop-down list listing all compatible tables for the selected list. By default, some tables are selected with hints on some attributes, if you select another table than the default ones, chances are there is no hint.

To add a new column, click on the "Add" button in front of the desired field. You can find this field in the section at the bottom of the page. In this last section, you can change the title, type and position of the columns. Once you are satisfied with the columns, click on the "Validate" button at the bottom right of the page. These columns will be added after those already added previously.

2.2 Templates

2.2.1 Presentation

Templates allow you to save column configurations. These models can be loaded from the corresponding back-office list.

Once a template is selected by an employee, it will be loaded for that employee at each session.

2.2.2 Configuration

Saving a template

Once you've added the columns to the configuration and want to save them to a template, click on the floppy disk at the top right of the table:

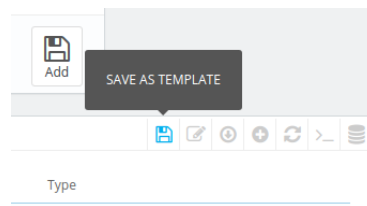


Figure 3: Save template button

A popup window is displayed and asking you for the name that the new template should have or to overwrite an existing model:

- Write the name you want to give to it or select the template to overwrite.
- Then click on the button in front of your field.

Loading a model

You can load the columns of a template into the configuration using the import logo at the top right of the list:

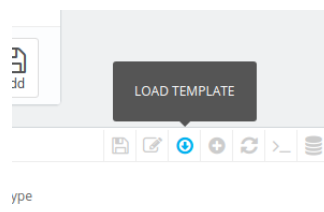


Figure 4: Template load button

A drop-down list will appear and you can choose which template loaded. **This does not change the template, you will need to save it if you want to save the changes.**

2.2.3 Using a template

Once your configuration is complete, you have to select the model from a back-office list. To do this, go to this list (for example, the "Orders" list) and click on the configuration logo at the top right of the list (the display may be different depending on the version of your store Prestashop):

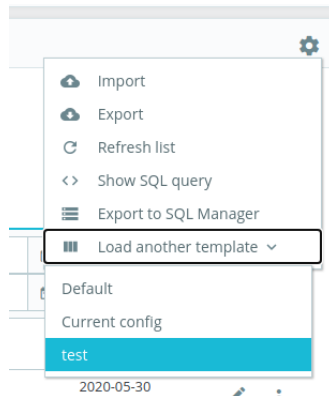


Figure 5: Load a template for a list (new versions)

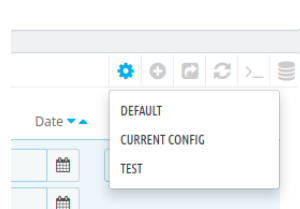


Figure 6: Load a template for a list (old versions)

You will have the choice between all your templates as well as two templates predefined by the module. By default, the selected template is "Current configuration" and allows you to directly load the selected columns on the configuration page. The template named "Default" loads the default columns of Prestashop.
NB:

- All templates are visible to all employees.
- A template can be selected by several employees.
- The template selected by an employee will be loaded for each of their sessions.
